 - a. U.S. Supreme Court
 - b. Congress creates inferior courts
- 5. Articles 4-7
 - a. 4 = Admitting new states
 - b. 5 = Amendment process
 - c. 6 = Supremacy Clause
 - d. 7 = Ratification
- 6. Principles of US Government
 - a. Popular Sovereignty
 - i. People are the source of power
 - b. Limited Government
 - i. Gov. has only the powers people give it
 - c. Federalism
 - i. National and State govs coexist.
 - d. Separation of Powers
 - i. Power is divided in 3 branches
 - e. Checks and Balances
 - i. Each branch can limit the others
- 7. Ratification Debate
 - a. Federalists
 - i. Support Constitution
 - ii. Division of powers would protect from tyranny
 - iii. Wrote Federalist Papers arguing merits of Constitution
 - b. Anti-Federalists
 - i. Opposed Constitution
 - ii. Responsible for addition of Bill of Rights (1st 10 amendments)
